Over the years, we focus has been on the development of poor and marginalized women, adolescents and children for their betterment of health and hygienic. Its activities have diversified in the fields of health, women's literacy, formal school education, non-formal education, rural employment, income generating skills, SHG formation, community health and awareness programmes on various social issues. The NGO is working in rural as well as urban areas of Thiruchirappali, Chennai and Kancheepuram district. Human Welfare Trust has received support from several donor organizations as well as from individuals. ### HEALTH CAMP

Human Welfare Trust has organized various health camp catering to all age groups in villages of Kancheepuram district. Held at Govt school, the medical team consisted of three general practitioners, a gynecologist, a pediatrician, a nurse, four support staff, and four optometrists. The camp provided medical service and consultation to the villagers, increased awareness about basic hygiene and preventive health care and helped determine the percentage of the most common diseases among the villagers. We have also helped for the people who had detected with problem for further treatment. We have motivated them to go for regular treatment till the disease get curd.

### **INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION**

Human welfare trust has celebrated our independence day on August 15<sup>th</sup> in Govt school for school children in order to motive them on nationalism and patriotism. We have organized cultural programme and completion for the school children. Many students has took part in the programme and bets one was awarded. Followed by we have orgainsed program in the village and the youths and women were took part in the programme. The Self Help Group were arranged the programme. Both cultural and completion were organized.

### **MAY DAY CELEBRATION**

International Labour Day is also known as the International Worker's Day and May Day which is celebrated on international level to promote and encourage the international labour associations. It is being celebrated all across the world every year on 1<sup>st</sup> of May which has been declared as the traditional spring holiday in India. We have organised the all the labour in order to honour them. We have organised cultural programme and they have enjoyed the show. Each one has enjoyed and expressed their thanks to us.

# **DISTRIBUTION OF EDUCATION MATERIALS**

Human welfare trust has collected list of poor children who is studying the school. We have raised fund for the well -wishers and have purchased the school materials for the children. Little children from deprived families are regularly motivated towards education. In order to encourage this Children Human Welfare Trust regularly conducts summer camp. Children are given specific training on personality development and also exposed to gain social orientation on new emerging areas. All children are supported by distributing notes, stationary, Geometry Box and School Bags. A total of 300 children benefitted through this programme this year.

### **TUITION CENTER FOR THE CHILDREN**

The main aim of this programme is to enhance the quality of life of children and youth through increased knowledge and skills. The trust also realized that merely imparting literacy would help the younger generation come up their life. Though many children have come from poor family, they were not offer to go for tuition to improve their education. So keeping this in our objective, we have organised free tuition center for the children. Nearly about 150 children were studying in the village .we have organised classes for the Standard wise . Special attention was given to the children who are appealing public examination.

# **COMPUTER TRAINING PROGRAMME FOR THE SCHOOL CHILDREN**

Computer knowledge is very minimal in rural schools due to lack of: electricity, skilled man power, good building infrastructures, and poverty, among others. Lack of computers in most of the rural communities makes access to information very expensive for everyone including children in primary schools. Computer skill is very much needed in this modern world, because in every field computer skills is needed for employment opportunity.so we were training the school children for the school to learn computer skill."Free computer training programme" for school children to improve basic knowledge and employability capability of children. The goal of the programme is to development of selfconfidence to face innovate and unfamiliarsituation. We have develop the rural school children such aptitudeand skills which will enable them to function better as productivecitizens. We have successfully enrolled 200 school going children in our training center.

# WATER SANITATION AND HYGIENE

With the aim of promoting safe drinking water, sanitation and hygiene regular education programmes are organized at various settings to include different beneficiaries. Awareness on use of sanitary latrines, in effects to open defecation, low cost construction techniques of latrines, and best hygiene behaviors all imparted to children and adults. In order ensure better awareness to the wider population, Human Welfare Trust also conducts campaign with the efforts of school children. We also motive the rural people to construct toilet in their house to avoid open defecation.

# **CELEBRATIONS OF INTERNATIONAL DAYS.**

Human Welfare trust has celebrated the **World Population day**, we instead the people on the impact of control of population in our country. **World Consumer day** were celebrated in order to emphasis on the rights of consumer among the general publics of rural community. Human Welfare Trust has observed **world Disability day**, distributed wheel chair for the disabled persons.

# WORLD WATER DAY

Human Welfare Trust has observed **World Forest day**, we motivate the children to plant trees in their school surroundings, we invited special resource person and given talk on protection of environment and also explained the importance of planting trees. We encourage the children to develop kitchen garden in the school and their houses.

# WORLD WATER DAY

Human Welfare trust has observed **World water day**, we have invited special quest and insisted the importance water conservation. We motivate the rural people to conserve water and rain water harvesting. We have also motivated them to keep their lakes and pond clean and hygienic. We have explained about the water borne disease and how to we protect from the.

# WORLD WOMEN DAY

Human welfare Trust has **world women Day** has organised in the community. We invited apecial speakers to awareness on their rights and health problems and also income generation proramme. We discussed the problems of the women violence and women welfare programmes. We explained the status of women in the nation, types of courts, free legal aid, etc., .nearly 400 women were participated from different villages of Kancheepuram district.

# **VOCATIONAL SKILL TRAINING**

With the aim of promoting livelihood among our economically deprived women Human Welfare Trust organized women in to Self Help Groups. Habits of savings and credit is taught and promoted among the members in these groups. Various Skill development trainings were conducted like readymade garment production, pickle making , bakery , Masala power making and food and beverage among these women members and the women were motivated towards taking up income generation projects. Similarly eight such groups were formed during this financial year and these groups were given vocational skill development and Entrepreneurship development trainings. We have also helped them for marketing their finished goods.
